Parental Notification Letter Regarding the Status of Program Improvement

August 30, 2016

Dear Parents/Guardians of Students at Long Valley Charter School:

This letter is to inform you that your child may be eligible to receive alternative supports and/or Public School Choice (Choice) during the 2016–17 school year. Long Valley Charter School entered the status of program improvement as a result of not achieving adequate yearly progress for two consecutive years (2011-2012 and 2012-2013). We remain in program improvement-year 2 until California establishes updated requirements.

Transition Plan for the 2016–17 School Year

As allowed by the Every Student Succeeds Act, California is developing a new accountability system for the 2017–18 school year. The 2016–17 school year is considered a “transition” year, designed to effect an orderly transition to the new law and accountability system. California has developed a transition plan that describes various alternative supports and services that are to be provided to eligible students.

Alternative Supports

During the 2016–17 school year, schools identified for PI Year 2 will be required to provide eligible students with alternative supports. Alternative supports are supplemental activities designed to increase the academic achievement of students.

Long Valley Charter School will offer the following alternative supports and services in 2016–17:

- Mastery-based learning for all students
- Academic Achievement Coach providing tutoring to students in small groups
- Web-based remediation tools accessible from school and home (i-Ready)
- We will work to help parents /guardians become involved at the school and home
- Instructional coaching for teachers to improve instruction to students
